Criteria for Receiving Assistance

3. There must be an inability of the local population to finish the project without outside help.
4. The project must be of scope and size as to allow Finish the Wall, to complete it in a reasonable time frame.
5. There must be a local church partner.

The final decision for providing assistance shall be made by the Board of Directors of Finish the Wall, inc.
